Read Your Bible Daily

Feed yourself and grow! Just as you eat everyday to nourish your body, feed your spirit everyday with the Word of God.

<u>The Bible is your light</u> "Your Word is a <u>lamp</u> to my feet and a <u>light</u> for my path." – **Psalm 119:105**

"All Scripture is God breathed and is useful for teaching...training in righteousness, so that every man of God may be thoroughly <u>equipped</u> for every good work." – **2Timothy 3:16-17**



Pray Daily

Pray Daily

What is prayer? How often should you pray? Simply put prayer is talking to God. You should pray as often as you think to do it.

"...The Lord will hear when I call to Him." – Psalm 4:3

"Pray continually; give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus." – 1Thessalonians 5:17-18

"This is the confidence we have in approaching God: That if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know He hears us – whatever we ask – we know that we have what we asked of Him." – **1John 5:14-15**

How do I pray?

Because God is an ever present, unseen friend, prayer is just talking to God. Simply talk to Him like sitting with a friend. But honor the Lord for who He is, God Almighty.

"Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name..." – Matthew 6:9

Hallowed - refers to making holy or treating as holy

Jesus taught the disciples how to pray, He gave them a model, not necessarily a prayer but an outline.

READ – Matthew 6:5-13

What should I pray?

Keep in mind that this is the God of the universe who loved you so much that he sent His Son to die for you so He could have this relationship with you. You are now His child and He loves to hear you speak with Him, just like a Father enjoys hearing his child's first words.

"Call to me and I will answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know." – **Jeremiah 33:3**



Prayer Pointers

• <u>Greet Him</u>. In any relationship, you begin by greeting that person.

"Our Father in heaven..." – Matthew 6:9

• <u>Express gratitude/appreciation</u> for His time and kindness. This is your praise and thanksgiving to God. Thank Him for all that He has done for you.

"Enter His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with praise." – Psalm 100:4

"For great is the Lord and most worthy of praise." – **Psalm 96:4**

• Ask Him for whatever you need that day.

"Give us today our daily bread." – Matthew 6:11

"...with thanksgiving, present your requests to God." – *Philippians 4:6*

• <u>Ask Him to forgive you for any sins</u> you may have committed that day.

"If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness." - 1John 1:9

"And if we stand praying. If you hold anything against anyone, forgive him, so that your Father in heaven may forgive you your sins." – **Mark 11:25**

• Ask Him to protect you, your family and friends.

"Save me, O God, by your name, vindicate me by Your might. Hear my prayer..." – **Psalm 54:1-2**

• <u>Finish prayer by thanking God</u> for His time and His concern for you and everyone.
