Your Life of Sin

Your life of sin

Before accepting Jesus as Lord and accepting His forgiveness you were a sinner. You failed to do what God requires to be in a right relationship with Him. You failed to obey God's law.

"...for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God..." - Romans 3:23

"All of us also lived among them at one time, gratifying the cravings of <u>our</u> <u>own</u> sinful nature and following its desires and thoughts..."

- Ephesians 2:3

Sin includes those things you do that are not acceptable to God, as well as your tendency to walk in disobedience to God.

As a sinner you cannot please God

Regardless of how hard you try or how "good" you think you are you cannot please God. Most people live without even considering what God may expect from us.

"As it is written: There is no one righteous, not even one; there is no one who understands, no one who seeks God. All have turned away, they have together become worthless; there is no one who does good, not one." - Romans 3:10

You were dead in your sin

Because God is holy (*Leviticus 11:44*) He will not allow sin in His presence. So while you were in your sin you were separated from God but when you were forgiven by Christ you were allowed to enter into His presence. It was by the blood of Christ that your sins were forgiven.

• Romans 5:9

"...we have been justified by His blood...saved from God's wrath through Him."

In the past you lived in the ways of the world.

• Ephesians 2:1-3

"...you were dead in your transgressions and sins, in which you used to live when you followed the ways of the world...we were by nature objects of wrath."

What Must I Do to Be Saved?

What must I do to be saved?

It's as easy as the learning the ABC's.

- ADMIT (you are a sinner)
 - o Romans 3:10, 23
- BELIEVE (in Jesus)
 - o John 14:6
 - o John 3:16
- CONFESS (Jesus is Lord)
 - o Romans 10:9

It is important that you realize that there is nothing you can do that will earn you access to heaven and there is no amount of money you can spend or give that will buy you access to heaven. It is <u>only</u> by the <u>grace</u> of God that you may have eternal life with Jesus.

"For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith – and this is not from yourselves, it is a gift of God – not by works, so that no man can boast." – **Ephesians 2:8-9**

When you firmly believe that it is through Christ alone you have salvation (not by anything you have done), you have "saving faith"!

Because of your faith in Christ, you now have grace and are in God's favor! Now you can enter God's presence boldly (Hebrews 4:16), knowing that you have received mercy and forgiveness. God accepts you through the work of Christ.
